Product Overview:

It ensures effective long-term protection of wood against wood-boring insects (including termites) and wood-destroying fungi (Dry Rot & Wet Rots), providing confidence in any issued long-term guarantee.

Typical Applications:

Suitable for both internal and external timbers, including fencing and cladding, where the timber is not in ground or water contact. Provides preservation against wood-boring insects, termites, and wood-destroying fungi.

Bats:

Contains active ingredients IPBC, Propiconazole, and Permethrin, which are approved for use in roof voids where bats roost at the levels outlined. Treatment must not be carried out while bats are present, and the Nature Conservancy body must be notified.

Application Guidelines:

Use when temperature is above 5°C. Dilute the Woodzone Dual Purpose 400gm container with 25 litres of water. Ensure timber is reasonably dry before treatment. Remove any paint, varnish, or other surface coatings as well as any bark to increase penetration of the treatment. The diluted product can be applied by brush or spray at a rate of 1 litre per 3-4m² of timber surface to refusal or timber may be dipped for a maximum of 3 minutes.

Coverage:

1 litre of diluted product covers 3-4m² of timber surface.

Contents:

- 3-IODO-2-PROPYNYL-N-BUTYL CARBAMATE (IPBC) – 6.125% w/w
- Propiconazole – 18.584% w/w
- Permethrin – 26.04% w/w
