Bats:

Contains active ingredients Permethrin and IPBC, which are approved for use in roof voids where bats roost at the levels outlined. Treatment must not be carried out while bats are present, and the Nature Conservancy body must be notified.

Typical Applications:

Suitable for the treatment of wood boring insects in both internal and external timbers.

Application Guidelines:

Use when temperature is above 5°C. Dilute the Woodzone Insecticide 150gm container with 25 litres of water. Ensure timber is reasonably dry before treatment. Remove any paint, varnish, or other surface coatings as well as any bark to increase penetration of the treatment. The diluted product can be applied by brush or spray at a rate of 1 litre per 3-4m² of timber surface to refusal or timber may be dipped for a maximum of 3 minutes.

Coverage:

1 litre of diluted product covers 3-4m² of timber surface
